Crawl Space Encapsulation

Overview

Frontier Basement Solutions was contacted by a homeowner that was complaining about a musty smell that was coming through the vents and into the house. The house did not have a basement but did have a dirt crawl space with poor ventilation. In the summer months it would become hot and humid in the crawl space causing a musty smell, and with the duct work running under the house it would pick up this smell and push it into the house through the vents.

The Process

Our Approach

1. We first addressed the problem by adding 2 vents to allow air to circulate through the crawl space.
2. We then encapsulated the entire crawl space with a combo liner that also acts as a radon barrier. This will eliminate any smells coming up through the dirt.

Our Solution



The Results

The total process only took a few days and now the homeowner doesn't have any musty or dirty smells coming up through the crawlspace and into the vents.
